
# On the **tannberg trail** from Warth to Schröcken.







### From the Steffisalp Express, via Bürstegg to Körbersee, and onto Schröcken/Nesslegg.

The hike begins with a ride on the Steffisalp Express. Once you reach the mountain station, most of the elevation gain is already covered, and the path continues towards Wannenkopf. From there, you can enjoy expansive views over Warth. The route then proceeds towards Bürstegg, a former Walser settlement that is charmingly nestled in the mountain landscape. The trail continues over the Karalpe to Auenfeldsattel and then descends to the Auenfeld meadows, where grazing cows are often seen. A narrow path leads past Körbersee, which is renowned for its serene environment. The final section of the hike descends to Nesslegg, the tour's destination.

Along the thematic route, there are cultural and natural historical landmarks marked as stations on the map. The attractive mountain landscape, in which these stations are set, tells the story of the rich culture, customs, and traditions of the Walser people, who have significantly shaped this region.
